Caring for Your Kitchen

Regular care and maintenance will help your kitchen remain beautiful, functional and long-lasting. The following guidelines are designed to prevent damage and preserve the quality of your joinery.

General Care

- Wipe surfaces regularly with a soft damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive or solvent-based cleaners.
- Wipe up spills immediately, especially around joins, sinks, dishwashers and appliances.
- Always use trivets or heat mats beneath hot pots, pans, and appliances such as toasters or air fryers.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to heat, moisture or steam – always use your rangehood when cooking.

- Do not flood floors when mopping; promptly dry kickboards, cabinetry edges and end panels.
- Use cutting boards and protective mats to prevent scratches, burns or cracking.
- Avoid leaning or hanging on doors and drawers.
- Periodically check and tighten hinges, handles, and runners to maintain alignment and function.
